

Winter Fans/Spectators/Guests,

To ensure the safety of our students, staff, community and spectators, Benton Community is limiting attendance to 2 spectators or their household per student-athlete for each competition hosted. The decision is based on several factors, including the Governor's recent proclamation.

Spectator Entry: (These will be the only people that will be granted admission into events)

- Each student-athlete/performer (player, cheer, dance, pep band) will be granted 2 spectators or their household for admission to the competition. Coaches are also allowed 2 spectators or their household.
- Rosters will be at the admission gate for spectators to check in.
- Admission is \$5.00 (*Exact change requested*)

Mitigation at Events:

- If you are not feeling well please stay home.
- Masks will be worn by all spectators for the duration of the event.
- Social distancing is required of people between different households.
- Spectators are only admitted for your student-athlete/performer's specific competition/performance. Spectators are asked to arrive no earlier than approximately 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start of their student-athlete/performer's competition/performance.
